# **SCOPE**

The Public Works Foreman shall be responsible to Town Council under the direction of the Town CAO.

### **FUNCTION**

The Public Works Foreman shall be responsible for the general management of all aspects of the Public Works Department including the Water and Sewer Utility System.

# **REQUIREMENTS**

- Proven supervisor and organizational skills
- Level 2 Water Treatment Certificate
- Level 1 Water Distribution Certificate
- Level 1 Wastewater Treatment and Collection (or prepared to obtain the certification on the above)
- A valid driver's license
- Preferred that candidate resides in the municipality

## **DUTIES**

- Develop and maintain good working relations with department heads, Council, boards, organizations and the public.
- Direct and supervise the public works personnel under his authority
- Schedule the work of the public works personnel under his authority
- Make recommendations to Council on any matter relating to the Public Works Department
- Keep Committee Chairpersons informed or aware problems/developments relating to their specific committees
- Be responsible for the supervision of construction and maintenance of water and sewer services, roads, sidewalks, traffic works, Town equipment and municipal property
- Attend Council meetings and applicable Committee meetings
- Assist in the administration and enforcement of Town bylaws
- Act in the capacity of License Inspector/Dutch Elm Disease Inspector
- Be actively involved in the day-to-day operation of the Public Works department
- Maintain such records and information as is required in the day-to-day operation of the Public Works Department
- Assist in the preparation of the annual operating budget
- Attend and participate in professional conventions, education courses, workshops and seminars
- Such other duties as may be assigned by Town Council or Town Administrator
