

2020 IS AN ELECTION YEAR!!

The next general election for urban municipalities (cities, towns, villages) will take place November 9, 2020. It is important to become involved in your community's affairs and exercise your democratic right to choose the leaders of your community! At least 10 business days before Nomination Day, the Returning Officer will publish and post a Notice of Call for Nominations stating the vacancies to be filled by the election.

Urban municipal councils are elected for 4-year terms, commencing with the first meeting following the election. Langenburg Town Council consists of an elected mayor and six councilors. Consider this your invitation to let your name stand for Council!
