Every Drop Counts

An increase to the water rates will effect each household in 2019. There will be a minimum of \$1.00 a month or \$3.00 a Quarter.

BE WATER WISE

If you commit just a little extra effort each day to save water, you alone can make a difference. Do our future generations a favour, conserve water.

Did you know A leaky toilet can waste as much as 950 litres of water per day or the volume of 12 bathtubs a day?

Effective February 19, 2019 the town will no longer be accepting application from tenants or other occupants. In order to ensure that the Registered Owner of a property is not left with a large outstanding bill when their tenant leaves town, all water bills will be billed to the Owner. The tenant will still be able to pay the bill at the town office or online on behalf of the Owner by providing the account number.

All new Owners are required to fill out a form with billing information, possession date and other required details. Please contact the office. 306.743.2432

A Water Meter Deposit of \$100.00 is required for each service.

If you require temporary or long term disconnect please contact the office. Failure to contact the office may result in bills during this period.

Water bills are Mailed Quarterly.




